# Our Mission

# Welcome

The path that leads one to a Pagan faith, is often not linear. Like the roots and branches of the various world trees, our paths twist, bend, and wind around each other as we embark on our respective journeys to find our gods and spirits.

My own path began with exploring solitary Wicca in my teens and twenties until I began to seek out open Pagan groups and circles. Now, nearly twenty years into my journey, I've found myself in the world of heathenry and very much involved in both my kindred and the wider Pagan community.

Some of us enjoy the solitude of solo worship and reflection, while others couldn't imagine honoring the gods without a group, coven, or kindred. Some of us dedicate ourselves to learning and maintaining a magickal practice, while others are content without it.

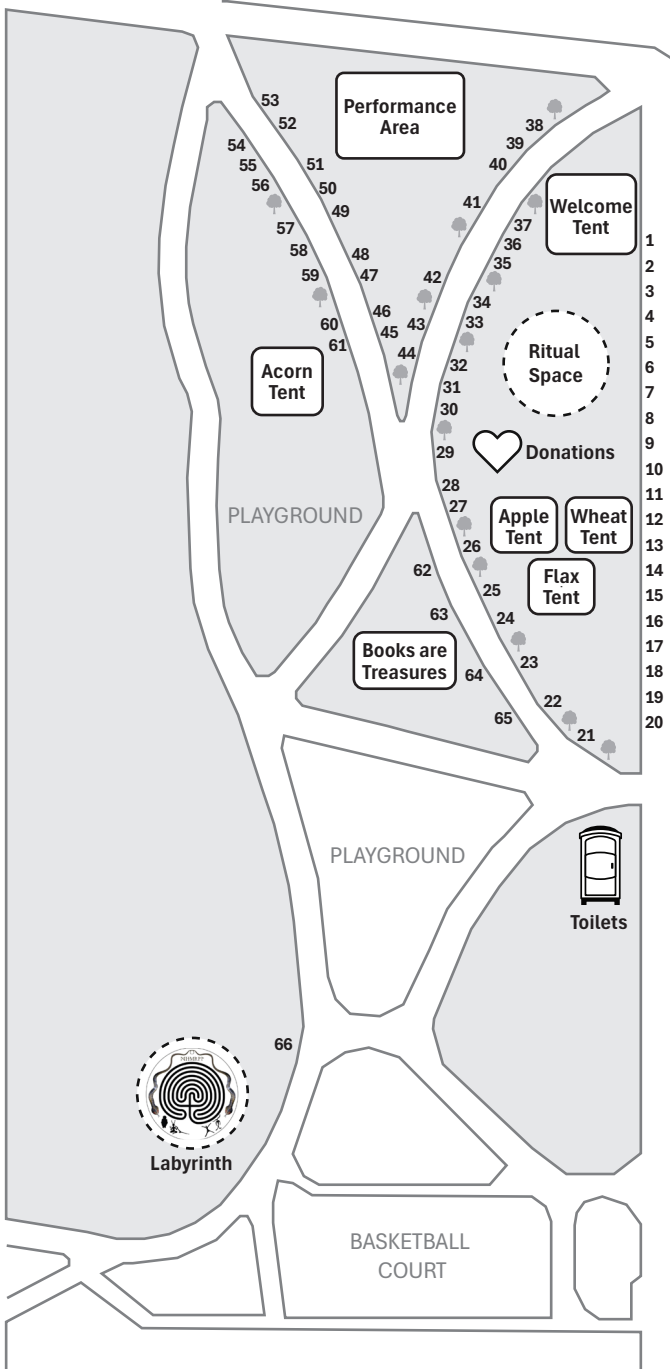

# Animal Magic Scavenger Hunt

## The hunt starts wherever you are right now!

The Magic of Animals is everywhere. Animal magic is found in literature. Animals are part of the Zodiac. Animal magic manifests in the mythologies of cultures throughout history. They represent aspects of nature and ourselves. Shamanic cultures, like our First Nation Tribes, utilize animal magic to teach us life lessons in Totem form.

Animals walk with us to empower us in life.

They evoke thoughts and feelings in their simplest and most profound forms.

As children when we play pretend that we are a tiger. In that moment we step outside ourselves. We become that beloved animal, feeling the strength and wisdom that comes from them.

As adults we disconnect from the becoming, to observing and categorizing. Animals and their magic are used on t-shirts, in sports mascots and in politics. Animal magic is even found in advertising.

We may joke in cavalier ways about our “spirit animals”... but those messages should be taken deeply like the medicine brought to us by the animals of our ancestors.

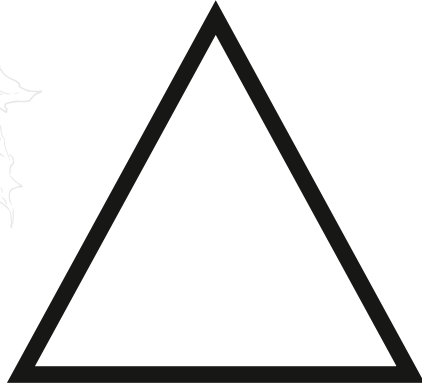

*(We have some animal rubber duckies as an alternative for our participants and tag-alongs who are 3 and under.)*

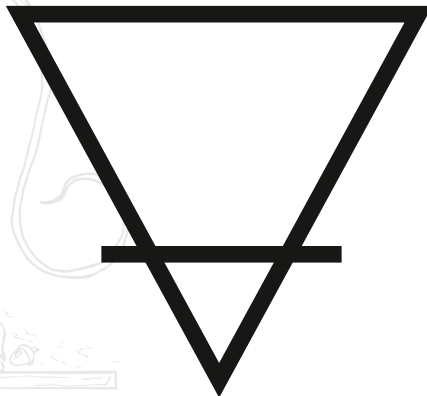

# DVPN and Philadelphia Pagan Pride Day, a Retrospective

Bob Bruhin and Franklin Evans were two of the co-founders of DVPN (Delaware Valley Pagan Network), and Bob brought the first Pagan Pride Day to Philadelphia about 25 years ago, with Bob and Franklin sharing the coordinator role. They will reminisce and tell stories about their mutual path to bringing a structure in which local and regional Pagans could connect, share, and join in ritual and friendship. They are deeply proud of the current leadership of Pagan Pride Day.



### Franklin Evans

I have the honor of being a co-founder of DVPN, and a past coordinator for Philadelphia Pagan Pride Day. I am called Chaos Mage. I style myself as a Shadow Warrior. I produced the ritual performance A Winter Solstice Singing Ritual, which I hope to bring back to Philadelphia in the near future. I was for 30 years an International Folk Dance (IFD) instructor and performer. Mostly, I perpetrate horrendous puns.



### Bob Bruhin

In addition to currently serving as Acting High Priest of Tenders of the Earth Temple, a coven under Assembly of the Sacred Wheel, Bob Bruhin is a hypnotherapist, web developer, tour guide, art photographer, author, blogger, and graphic designer. In 1998 he helped found Delaware Valley Pagan Network, the parent organization behind the original Philadelphia Pagan Pride Day. Bob also served as Philadelphia local and Mid-Atlantic regional coordinator for the International Pagan Pride Project in the early 2000s.

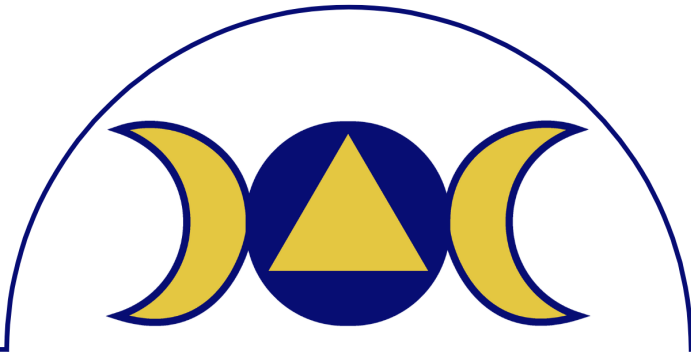
